- Seek and follow police advice about incident management, what information can be given to others, how to support and protect those involved, and how to secure evidence.
- Record police reference number and advice given.
- Do not prejudice a potential criminal investigation.
- Carefully document any information provided by children, young people and others.
- Give police the chance to contribute any plans.
- Continue to work in partnership with police.
- Seek legal advice from your sector's legal services or via your sector office where offences are involved.

Report critical incidents

- Report to the Education Director Manager, Family Day Care Programs (government).
- Report to CESA School Performance Leader (Catholic).
- Report to AISSA CE or Head of Legal Services (independent).
- Document critical incidents in critical incident reporting system (government) (see timeframes in the procedure).
- Report to Education Standards Board (preschools, FDC, LDC/rural care program and OSHC only) with [legislated timeframes](#)
