In these cases, applications will be considered based on the distance from the school, personal needs, such as curriculum (excluding special interest programs), transportation/location convenience, and individual/family needs.

Enter for Success Strategy Year 7 students

Through nominating Riverbanks College B2 via the Enter for Success strategy, a child who identifies as Aboriginal and/ or Torres Strait Islander will be offered a Year 7 place at the school for the following year. Families enrolling through Enter for Success must do so at the end of term 4 in the year prior to starting Year 7.
